

NOTICE & DECLARATION

— OF PROSCRIPTION AND EXCLUSION —

(AND OF THE INALIENABLE RIGHT TO THE RULE OF LAW)

I hereby swear and declare the truth and authenticity of the factual contents of the *Integrity Ireland Report* entitled, “*Criminality in the Irish Courts – and the absence of the Rule of Law*” ISBN: 978-1-906628-88-8 upon which basis I declare the 100+ individuals named therein who have engaged in proven criminal conduct to be individually and personally liable for the same according to law, and, inasmuch as the organs and institutions of the Irish State continue to fail and refuse to address the said criminal conduct and/or to sanction the individuals involved according to the Rule of Law, that the said accused persons are hereby deemed “proscribed and excluded” from any and all dealings in their official capacities with myself and/or with any other resident or citizen of this State who lawfully objects to any such contact, interaction or association with the named accused on the strength of: (i) the self-evident contents of the published I-I Report; (ii) upon the Rule of Law; (iii) upon the inalienable and fundamental rights of the individual; and (iv) upon the moral and legal imperative which is binding upon all right-thinking persons; that they do NOT knowingly engage with, encourage, facilitate, endorse, reward and/or participate in amoral or unlawful conduct – nor knowingly, willingly or freely associate with known criminals in furtherance or pursuit of criminal actions, as per the definitions of ‘criminal activity’ and ‘criminal organisation’ as laid out in the Criminal Justice Acts of 2006 and 2009.

Submissions should comprise no more than three A4 pages, digitally composed and/or typewritten and containing an original, annotated and witnessed signature in blue ink. Any and all such correspondence will be given full and appropriate consideration. Please allow up to 40 days for a response. Submissions that do not meet the stated criteria may be disposed of, in which case no further contact or discussion will be entered into except in the case of formal proceedings through the domestic Courts and/or through the Peoples Tribunal of Ireland.
