NOTICE

A respectful advisory to Castlebar Courts Office and the Special District Criminal Court sitting on Monday July 4th 2016.

Please be advised that I, Stephen Manning, the 2nd named Defendant in this matter was prevented from speaking at the hearing of June 15th last; that I was likewise denied proper audience at the hearing of June 1st last; and that I was subsequently denied due and proper access to the Courts on both occasions.

That I was also given no proper opportunity to inform the Court of my schedule and several attempts to communicate with Castlebar Office Manager Peter Mooney since, have been completely ignored.

Accordingly, I have today emailed and phoned Castlebar Courts Service with a detailed advisory as to why I cannot attend Castlebar Court on July 4th and why I am declaring my belief that the hearings of June 1st and June 15th were unlawful and illegitimate and were in clear contravention of certain Articles and Protocols as contained within the European Convention on Human Rights.

These matters are currently being brought to the attention of the Superior Courts and the ECHR in accordance with law.

In the meantime, I respectfully reiterate my constitutional and personal objections to being coerced, forced, intimidated or otherwise unlawfully co-opted into participating in any unlawful or unconstitutional situation or circumstance which jeopardises my fundamental human rights or my rights under the Irish Constitution.
